





Pajulahti and Finland are calling you again

The third Para Finland Open will be played familiarly and safely at the Pajulahti Sports Institute. After the national and international feedback we have received, we dare to estimate that, at least in terms of accessibility, it is almost in the best conditions in the world.

Even last year we got a bit of the corona pandemic, or at least its aftermath. However, the competition itself went great, as did our first trial in 2019. Is that the reason that Para Finland Open 2023 filled up at a record pace and we even had to limit the number of participants. It was a surprise, at least for us, because the predictions were different.

One explanation for the competition's popularity, in addition to the circumstances, can be the fact that our own para players are doing a good job in the world. Aino Tapola and Timo Natunen are successful in their respective classes at or near the top, and young Aaro Mäkelä is making strong progress in class M6. Aino's runner up position in World Championships W1 class was a fierce demonstration of determined effort.

We gather about 300 people in Pajulahti in autumn. They are players, coaches, assistants, judges, classifiers and the people running the competition. The amount is large and places considerable demands on the personnel responsible for the arrangements as well. However, I dare to trust that we will be able to organize this event better and better every time.

The Finnish para players have practiced a lot in Pajulahti, which is one of the best partners of Finnish Table Tennis Association. It's no wonder that Pajulahti is also known as the National Paralympic Training Center. We warmly thank both Pajulahti and the Ministry of Education and Culture, which is the financial guarantor of the competition.

Dear lovers of para table tennis, you are very welcome to Para Finland Open 2023 and Pajulahti.

In Pajulahti you don't need any transportation. Venues and all other facilities are in the same area.

Arrival

LOC will provide transportation services to teams from the airport to Pajulahti Olympic and Paralympic Training Center.

ATM


